SICA-USA 2024 Year-End Report Submitted by Fayra Teeters, Chair January 19, 2025



## Summary:

SICA-USA awarded two Project Grants in 2024:

- 1. Dahlan & Honora Foah's oratorio *Blood&Breath* had a world premiere at the Vatican in Rome in October 2024. In February, SICA awarded \$1000 towards music composition (Lucas Richman, composer) with rehearsals taking place in Atlanta, GA and Bangor, Maine. Foah's final report submitted in December and published in the SICA newsletter blog that same month with Vatican event photos.
- 2. The Amani Center was awarded \$1000 Project Grant towards the purchase of a Damon Hyldreth sculpture including an unveiling event held June 2, 2024.

## Changes to the Board of Directors and support staff:

- 1) Jim O'Halloran joined the Board February 4, 2024, taking over the duties of Treasurer in June.
- 2) Phoebe Hoffman commissioned in March as SICA tech assistant to post weekly newsletter blogs.
- 3) In August, the following board positions were put in place:
  - a) Fayra Teeters as Chair, project grant manager, newsletter blog editor
  - b) Jim O'Halloran as Treasurer and insurance manager
  - c) Roberta Hoffman as Secretary and website manager
  - d) Lawrence Pevec as International Liaison
- 4) Alexandra Boyer joined the board in October as National Helper liaison, fully participating in meetings and contributing to monthly board "musings" articles.

## SICA Participatory Events:

- 1) March 22 Spring Equinox, Passover, Easter blended ceremony / feast event at Portland Subud House organized by Fayra Teeters.
- 2) Spring Pledge-drive for yearly funding in April, raised \$1000.
- 3) June 2<sup>nd</sup> Amani Center unveiling of Damon Hyldreth sculpture; Roberta Hoffman attended in person with the SICA banner; Lawrence Pevec delivered a speech via zoom.
- 4) June National Gathering in Portland attended by Lawrence Pevec, Jim O'Halloran, & Fayra Teeters. Lawrence served as videographer; Jim performed during the evening concert and conducted a workshop; Fayra conducted a workshop on using theatrical archetypes to realize cultural flow.
- 5) July International Congress attended by Lawrence Pevec who served as videographer, and represented SICA-USA at SICA International meetings; wrote an article featuring SDIA annual report to congress.
- 6) In August Jim O'Halloran's jazz band performed at Bradner Gardens in Seattle WA,
- 7) SICA International zoom meeting attended by Lawrence in November, during which he participated in major restructuring efforts.
- 8) In November the board revised/consolidated the SICA-USA Bylaws to bring them into compliance with current practices, eliminate conflict of interest, update voting practices, plus the scheduling and presentation of event and budget reports. A copy of the Bylaws is attached to this report.
- 9) Dec 15<sup>th</sup> Fayra Teeters led a blended Winter Solstice, Christmas, Hannukah Celebration at the Portland Subud House.
