In addition to Benedict writing and performing his own material, Morris McClellan served as recording producer, and Michael Herrman served as musical director and sound editor. The book will be published on Amazon Audio Books, audible.com and iTunes.com in 2026.

The National Congress in June was attended by Lawrence Pevec and Roberta Hoffman, who tended a breakout room featuring SICA-USA merchandise available in as a gift honoring a yearly donation, or simply for purchase.
